

Faculty of engineering economics, media technologies and social sciences conducts educational program of Georgian language learning. The objective of the program is to teach Georgian not only to foreigners but Georgian citizens of non-Georgian origin as well (representing ethnic minorities). Teaching comprises all four aspects: reading, writing, oral comprehension and speaking at the level required for under-graduate studies at universities, as well as communication and integration into local society.

Applicants who are Georgian citizens (Azerbaijanis, Abkhazians, Ossetians and Armenians) can be admitted after having passed Common National Entrance Examinations only in general skills. This procedure does not concern foreign applicants. They will be admitted without passing any test in accordance with the Law on Education of Georgia.

The educational program has 60 credits and lasts for one academic year. Classes in this program can be taken only during the first year at university and after the completion of it appropriate certificate will be provided.

Tuition fee is 2250 GEL
